Voting membership of Gilnahirk Presbyterian Church

At this important period in the Congregational life of Gilnahirk Presbyterian Church, Session is required to ensure that our roll of eligible voting members is up to date and properly reflective of our Church community.

To be a voting member of GPC, <u>both</u> of the following requirements must be met:

- 1) be a communicant member on the church roll
- 2) be recorded by name or number, as having contributed to the freewill offering of the congregation in the last financial year (for current purposes of our vacancy process, that will be Jan-Dec 2025) We have recently reviewed the list of communicant members. We are also keen to ensure understanding of, and compliance with, requirements for recorded financial contribution.

If you are a communicant member, and don't currently contribute via Freewill offering envelopes or Standing Order, please consider doing so prior to the end of this financial year.
