Sunday 1 June

- **Moderator** | Pray for the Moderator as he attends the RUC George Cross service in Enniskillen and then in the evening joins with Banagher as they celebrate their 200-year anniversary. Pray for safe travels.
- **General Assembly 2025** This year's General Assembly will take place from Tuesday 10 June Thursday 12 June. Following last year's format, the installation of the new Moderator will take place in the middle of the proceedings on Wednesday 11 June at 4.30pm. In addition, there are more worship sessions, offering a time of reflection in the midst of the busyness. If you can, please consider coming along to the General Assembly, you would be very welcome. As the final preparations are made, we pray for God's guidance, grace and blessing on all the business reports given, debates heard, times of worship and praise, and conversations had during the week.

Monday 2 June

- Stephen & Angelina Cowan, global mission workers, Kenya | Give thanks for all the time and effort invested by the SAA leadership and the Nairobi teams before and during the 10-day youth camp. Pray that the children and young people would remember and be encouraged by what they have learned, especially as many return to difficult situations.
- The Presbyterian Church of Myanmar (PCM), Myanmar | Pray for PCM's ongoing relief work following the recent earthquake, especially for the reinforcement and renovation of the PCM Centre in Mandalay and for the earthquake victims accommodated there.

Tuesday 3 June

- International Meeting Point (IMP), Rev Colin Dickson | Pray for IMP as it seeks to 'love God and love the stranger in the city' (Deut. 10:19). Thank God for his grace and strength given to staff and volunteers who compassionately seek to create a place of welcome, where the gospel and mercy ministries are shared with everyone on a daily basis.

Wednesday 4 June

Pray for the children's summer Bible club, for opportunities through it to share the gospel message with children and their families. Pray that new connections will be made and existing relationships developed.
- **Church Planting** | The Church Planting Panel is planning a conference in February 2026 to encourage and equip leaders and core teams for church planting. Pray the Panel will be led by God as it selects themes, content and speakers to best support the growth of new churches across Ireland.

Friday 6 June

- **Social Witness Regional Managers** | Pray for the Personnel Department who continue to support Regional Managers in staffing each of our services. Pray for new staff joining the Council, that they will settle in quickly and develop good working relationships with other staff, and will have a real commitment to providing the best possible care to our residents.
- **Assisted Dying** | As the Terminally Ill Adults (End of Life) Bill goes for its 3rd Reading in Westminster, please pray for wisdom for politicians, that this Bill will be defeated. Pray also for those suffering from a terminal or life limiting illness and their families, that they will be affirmed that they are loved and are valuable members of our society.

Saturday 7 June

- **General Council** | Pray for the Conferencing and Buildings Department, headed up by Raymond Robinson, as they continue to make preparations for this year's General Assembly. Pray for the small team and the many tasks that lie before them in organizing the logistical elements of the Assembly.
