Sunday 12 April

- **Moderator** | *Jesus said the fields are white unto harvest and the workers are few. Pray for ministers and missionaries to be raised up by God to go out into the harvest fields and proclaim the good news.*
- **Worship: After Easter** | *Ask that as we worship in the afterglow of Easter we would be inspired and equipped to walk in the light, life and liberty of the gospel.*

Monday 13 April

- **Naomi Keefe, global mission worker, Brazil** | *Pray that the Holy Spirit would use the words of Naomi and those with whom she works, to communicate the gospel. Pray that many boys and girls and their families would come to know Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and that the light and love of Christ would shine through all the various activities, events and visits that Naomi participates in or helps to organise week by week so that in all things, glory would be given to God.*
- **The Association for Theological Education in Nepal (ATEN)** | *Give thanks for ATEN's Library of over 28,000 titles and for its commitment to supporting education, research, and spiritual growth through accessible and organized library services. Pray that new and relevant publications would continue to be made available to its rapidly growing readership from theological colleges, churches, pastors and students from all over Nepal.*

Tuesday 14 April

- **Naas** | *Pray for Naas congregation and their considerations to alter the interior of the meeting house. Pray for decisions about whether to proceed and that, if so, the changes can be implemented smoothly and be a blessing to the congregation and their mission.*
- **Heidi England, deaconess, Railway Street, Lisburn** | *Give thanks for the discipleship groups and for the recent Christianity Explored course. Pray that, as those taking part turn to God's Word, the Holy Spirit will apply it to their lives, so that Christ may be formed in them.*

Wednesday 15 April

- **Stephen and Angelina Cowan, global mission workers, Kenya** | *Give thanks for the ongoing ministries of the Samburu Awareness and Action Programme (SAAP) and for daily interactions with the community. Pray that Christ's love would shine through every aspect of community involvement and especially for SAAP's weekly engagement in the primary school teaching programme, which is attended by over half the pupils in the upper primary classes.*
- **Christ the Saviour Presbyterian Church (CTS), Poland** | *Pray that Rev Sashko Nezamutdinov would be granted much wisdom and encouragement as he pastors the Christ the Saviour Congregation. Pray for effective ministry amongst children and young people, especially for the 'Vibe' Youth club that meets each Saturday. Pray also for the ongoing publication of Christian literature, that it would be used by God to reach those seeking meaning and purpose to their lives.*

Thursday 16 April

- **St Columba's, Lisburn (Urban Mission)** | *Give thanks to God with St Columba's Church, Lisburn for their newly refurbished church hall, their current place of worship and gathering as they seek to replace the leaking church roof. In this season of transition, pray that God would use Rev Rodney Cameron and the congregation to minister with compassion, welcome and grace to all whom they encounter.*
- **Mission as a Minority** | *Give thanks for the recent publication of a report entitled '[Mission as a Minority](#)', approved by the 2025 General Assembly, which has been developed into a more enhanced tool with practical examples and reflection questions added in a more accessible format. Pray that this would be a helpful tool for considering approaches to mission in areas where Presbyterians represent a significant minority and there is a need to cross cultural boundaries in reaching out to others.*

Friday 17 April

- **Bereavement** | *Pray for those known to us who are bereaved and coping with grief. Pray as they mourn a loved one, that they will know God's loving arm around them. Remember those at the various stages of grief – shock, disbelief, confusion, depression, anger and acceptance. Give thanks for the support of loving friends and family and the comfort of God's presence.*
- **International Relations** | *There are many global issues presenting significant challenges to world leaders. Pray for wisdom in decision-making, opportunities for positive collaboration, and outcomes which de-escalate tensions. Pray also for agencies providing support to people displaced in areas of conflict.*

Saturday 18 April

- **General Council** | *Please remember all the various Councils, committees, panels and task groups as they finalise their contributions for the Annual Report Book. Pray that they might know God's guidance and inspiration as they seek to communicate the work and the vision of the groups they represent.*
- **Training in Ministry** | *Pray for the present deaconess trainees, Sonya Boal and Olivia Smyth. Pray that their placements, with Sonya in Elmwood, Lisburn, and Sonya in Wellington, Ballymena, will be nurturing environments for them, as they learn all the aspects of their calling.*
