Sunday 5 April

- **Moderator** | *Pray that the message of Jesus Christ (mighty to save) would ring out clearly in dawn services and church services. It's good to remember that faith, hope and love originate in our living Saviour.*
- **Worship: Easter Sunday** | *Ask that God would enable us to experience afresh as we worship the wonder of his love for us in Jesus and the resurrection power that makes us more than conquerors over all that stands against us in our lives.*

Monday 6 April

- **Csaba & Ilona Veres, global mission workers, Hungary** | *Give thanks for steady progress in the renovating of the Imahaz/Prayer House and for the team coming to assist with this work from Kilbride Presbyterian Church for a week in April. Pray especially for the resourcing of much-needed work on the roof and insulation of the building. Pray that all the ongoing ministries would be deeply rooted in the Word of God and prayer.*
- **Theological Education by Extension Malawi (TEEM)** | *Pray for the Acting Executive Director of TEEM, Rev Chuma George Njabili, that he would know God's guidance and encouragement in developing the work. Pray that God would work mightily through TEEM to develop Christian leaders of vision, integrity, wisdom and resilience.*

Tuesday 7 April

- **Moville, Greenbank, Carndonagh and Malin** | *Give thanks for the congregations of Moville, Greenbank, Carndonagh and Malin and pray for Rev Philip Poots as he ministers there. Give thanks for the attendance of elders at a recent Home Mission event and pray that they would be enthused and encouraged as they seek to serve God in this area.*
- **Lyndsey Ballentine, assistant chaplain, Queen's University Belfast** | *Give thanks for the community that God has created in Derryvolgie this year. Pray for the students as they prepare for upcoming exams and assignments. Pray for God's wisdom as the team processes applications and plans for the upcoming Open Day.*

Wednesday 8 April

- **Derek & Jane French, global mission workers, Spain** | *Give thanks for the students who have been coming along to the Bilbao International Church (BIC), that each would experience a warm welcome and feel at home. Pray that God would place it on the heart of young people to commit to serve as interns in BIC's student ministry and other areas of church life. Remember especially Jinoj and Mahija who, for a number of months, will take charge of the students' Bible study that meets each Friday.*
- **Leaders in Training (LITs)** | *Pray for Rev John Mbae, that he would be able to successfully combine a heavy workload as Deputy Secretary General of the Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA), with his ongoing studies in Business Administration & Management at the ZETECH University, Nairobi. Pray that these studies would enhance all that he contributes in his leadership role, one that is so strategic in the life of PCEA.*

Thursday 9 April

- **West Belfast Special Ministry, Rev David Moore** | *Give thanks that since weekly worship services began in February there have been new people attending almost every week. Give thanks also that some of these, and others, have begun to attend the weekly Bible study.*
- **Oisin Kelly, community outreach worker, Fermoy and Cahir** | *Give thanks for the outreach work led by Oisin in these two communities. Pray particularly for the secondary school programme in Cahir, that lives would be touched by the truths shared and that it would open doors to further ministry. Pray also for the developing youth group in Cahir as it gets established.*

Friday 10 April

- **Illness** | *Pray for those in our families and friendship circles who have suffered sudden illness recently. Give thanks for the NHS and healthcare professionals, including paramedics and rapid response teams who are often heroes in emergency situations – there to provide care when those who take ill suddenly need it the most.*
- **Cost of Living** | *Pray for those who are feeling pressure due to the rising cost of living. Give thanks for organisations like CAP, Storehouse and the Trussell Trust seeking to help people in times of need. Pray for policy and decision makers as they try to find ways to mitigate the impact in the short and longer term.*

Saturday 11 April

- **General Council** | *Pray for the General Council meeting on Tuesday 14 April as we prepare for the General Assembly. So often we do not know what to do but our eyes are on the Lord. May he direct us faithfully and clearly.*
- **Training in Ministry** | *Pray for all who are being interviewed as candidates for the ordained ministry, having been nominated by their presbyteries. Pray for a clear sense of the Lord's guidance, both for the candidates and for the Council interview panels.*
