Sunday 24 May

- **Worship in the family of God** | *'Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters.'* Hebrews 13:1. Give thanks for your congregational family and ask that God would bless your time together in worship today.
- **Edwin and Anne Kibathi, global mission workers, London, UK** | *Pray that the women's meetings due to take place in different congregations during May will go well and for preparations for Women's Guild Week in June. Pray also for the PCEA young people, especially for those who are sitting exams this month, that they would be able to perform to the best of their ability.*
