## Sunday 22 March

- **Moderator** | *In this season of Girls' and Boys' Brigade displays pray for connections to be made with local communities. Pray too for those who speak at displays that they will have a word from the Lord.*
- **Worship: Expressing our praise** | *As we worship today ask God to help us to do with hearts grateful and thankful for all that he is to us and does for us.*

## Monday 23 March

- **Neil and Jenny Stewart, global mission workers, Spain** | *Please pray for Neil and Jenny as they seek to improve their knowledge of the Spanish language and learn more about life and culture in the Basque Region. Pray that they will be able to deal with a few last, remaining administrative matters, in particular as they navigate the tax system and apply for the 'numerous family' status that they are entitled to in Spain. Pray that the children would continue to get involved in activities and make more new friends.*
- **The Church of Central Africa Presbyterian, Zambia Synod (CCAP Zambia)** | *Give thanks for the Synod's 'Walk with us' Disaster Response Project set up to provide emergency relief following the recent flooding that affected vulnerable communities in Lundazi and surrounding areas. Pray that the essential household supplies would continue to reach the worst affected families as they seek to recover from the devastation caused by the flooding.*

## Tuesday 24 March

- **Carlow and Athy** | *Give thanks for the ministry of Rev Stephen Rea over the past 16 years. Pray for the new elders of Carlow and the Kirk Session of Athy, as they continue to give leadership to the congregation and consider their witness in the local area.*
- **Robert Dalzell, South Belfast Friendship House** | *Pray for wisdom for Robert as he leads the project, particularly for growth and impact of the programmes, and that people would feel valued, supported, and draw closer to God. Give thanks for new opportunities for outreach and pray that God would open doors for meaningful connections.*

## Wednesday 25 March

- **Edwin and Anne Kibathi, global mission workers, London, UK** | *Pray that Edwin and Anne will have experienced rest and renewal during their visit to Kenya in February and early March, and now be able to quickly adjust and settle back into their respective roles with PCEA UK Outreach, both in London and further afield.*
- **The Evangelical Christian Church of Halmahera, Indonesia (GMIH)** | *Give thanks that with the encouragement of a scholarship from PCI, Rahel Tempomona, a student for ministry in GMIH, is able to continue with her second year of doctoral studies in Christian Education at the Institute Agama Kristen Negeri (IAKN) in Toraja. Pray that these studies will contribute to Rahel becoming a more effective leader and educator in the life of the church.*

## Thursday 26 March

- **Central, Belfast (Urban Mission)** | *Give thanks for this, the youngest, congregation of the Presbyterian Church in Ireland, particularly praising God for the welcoming of 150 new communicant members recently, over half of which were on profession of faith. Pray for the ongoing process of calling a minister to serve the congregation, remembering the nominee who will preach and be considered by the congregation in the coming weeks.*
- **Claire Sellar, hospital chaplain, Ulster Hospital** | *Pray for the continued development of Claire's walk with God so that she is used by Christ to minister to those with whom she comes into contact; for the discernment and wisdom in prioritising who and when to attend to patients. Pray that God will minister to the hearts, minds and souls of his people while they are in hospital, for unseen workers who do so much to keep the hospital functioning, including the support teams who cater and clean, the estate workers who maintain the buildings and grounds and for those who provide security.*

## Friday 27 March

- **Aaron House** | *This residential care home in Dundonald offers permanent and respite care for people from Belfast and South Eastern Social Care Trusts who have a profound learning disability. Pray for staff as they care for the residents, and give thanks for Susan Stewart, manager, and Pauline Allen, interim day care manager, as they oversee the care and support of the residents.*
- **Healthcare** | *Give thanks for healthcare chaplains, for the support that they are to both patients and families during life's difficulties. Pray for them as they navigate our changing culture and as they continue to be salt and light where they work.*

## Saturday 28 March
