Sunday 2 November

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the Moderator as he commences his tour of Ards Presbytery. Pray that the logistics might run smoothly and that the various meetings will be productive as numerous engagements are undertaken across the Presbytery, and that all the congregations involved will be encouraged in their ministry and witness. As part of Belfast's annual Irish language festival, the Moderator will also be attending an Irish language service in Fitzroy this afternoon, at which Rev Patricia McBride will preside and Rev Jim Stothers will preach. Pray that the service will be a blessing to all who attend.*
- **Worship that enriches** | *One thing I ask from the LORD, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the LORD and to seek him in his temple. Psalm 27:4. Ask that God would enrich us through encountering the beauty of who he is in worship today.*

Monday 3 November

- **Stephen & Angelina Cowan, global mission workers, Kenya** | *Give thanks for the work of the Samburu Awareness and Action Programme in the Mount Nyiru and Ndoto Mountains areas over many years. Pray for ongoing conversations with the PCEA leadership at presbytery and denominational level, that God would grant clarity of vision for and commitment to ongoing ministry and mission in this region of northern Kenya.*
- **The Reformed Church in Hungary (RCH)** | *Pray for Bishop József Steinbach, Ministerial President of the RCH Synod, as he encourages the church to look to the risen Christ as the source of their hope in these uncertain days. Pray that God would grant him much wisdom, sustaining grace and encouragement in this key leadership role.*

Tuesday 4 November

- **Angela Hamilton, community outreach worker, West Kirk, Belfast** | *Continue to pray for the women's Bible study group as they meet each week. Give thanks for several new members joining the group. Pray that everyone will be blessed as they fellowship and grow together in Christ.*
- **Healthcare chaplaincy** | *Give thanks for the recent appointment of Rev Craig Wilson to a part-time healthcare chaplaincy role in Letterkenny University Hospital. Pray for Rev Wilson as he combines these additional duties with ministry in nearby congregations.*

Wednesday 5 November

- **Naomi Keefe, global mission worker, Brazil** | *Give thanks for the wide range of activities that have taken place in the past month, not least for the children and adults who attended the evangelism training sessions just recently. Pray that these sessions would continue to inspire those who attend to have courage to speak to their friends about Jesus.*
- **The Presbyterian Church of East Africa (PCEA)** | *Give thanks for PCEA's four million members across 61 presbyteries in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda. Pray for the denominational leadership in all they do to fulfill PCEA's vision to empower, equip, build and transform God's people for effective service throughout East Africa.*

Thursday 6 November

- **Maynooth, Rev Keith McCrory** | *Give thanks for the witness of this congregation in Maynooth, particularly for the growth in the past year and the welcoming of new members. Pray for the ongoing outreach activities in the congregation & the developing work among students.*
- **Phoebe Nugent, community outreach worker, Ebrington** | *Give thanks for Phoebe's work in Ebrington, particularly in developing community outreach and work among young people. Pray for encouragements in the ongoing weekly programmes through new contacts and increased discipleship.*

Friday 7 November

- **Refugee and Asylum Seekers** | *Pray for those who have arrived in Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland seeking asylum and who find themselves in hotel accommodation or Direct Provision Centres. Pray that they would be able to access the services they need – health, education etc. – and that they would be able to make positive connections with one another and people in the community, including local congregations.*
- **Peacehaven Trust** | *Peacehaven has three residential properties for adults with a learning disability in Greystones, Co Wicklow. Pray for Michael Williams, manager, along with the staff and residents. Remember the residents as they attend day services, as well as activities in and out of the houses. Pray that residents will be happy and fulfilled in their daily lives.*

Saturday 8 November

- **General Council** | *Pray for the meeting of the General Council taking place on 12 November, as it meets to begin the process of enacting some of the decisions from this year's General Assembly and to start planning for General Assembly 2026.*
- **Training in Ministry** | *Pray for current ministry applicants and presbytery interview panels as they embark on the application process for this year. Pray that those who have a sense of call may find that this is tested in a manner that is God-glorifying, and where the Lord's guidance is seen by all.*
