Sunday 8 March

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the next Clerk of the General Assembly and those who will be considering this important position in our denomination. The job has now been advertised and the leading of God will be necessary to secure the right candidate.*
- **Worship: Experiencing God's grace** | *As we worship today ask God to help us to know his forgiving and sustaining grace, pardoning our sins and providing for all our needs.*

Monday 9 March

- **Derek and Jane French, global mission workers, Spain** | *Pray for Derek and Jane, that they would both continue to make steady recoveries following significant health issues.
