Sunday 1 February

- Moderator** | Use the words of Paul in Ephesians 3:17-19 as the basis of our prayers: 'Being rooted and grounded in love, may we have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God'.
- Worship: Desiring God's presence** | "Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you!" Isaiah 64:1. Ask for a real and meaningful sense of God's presence in worship today.

Monday 2 February

- Csaba and Ilona Veres, global mission workers, Hungary** | Pray for good, consistent attendance at Sunday services, Bible studies, the women's group and the youth group, that these gatherings would be rooted in the Word and full of unwavering prayer. Pray as food and firewood are delivered, that new friendships would form and there would be 'open doors' for the gospel, so that many would come to trust in Jesus Christ and grow in his love and grace.
- Presbyterian Church in Brazil (IPB)** | Give thanks to God for the IPB's missionary work in the Amazon region. Pray for chaplains as they provide effective spiritual care, reminding everyone of God's presence in the midst of suffering and uncertainty.

- Derek and Jane French, global mission workers, Spain** | Give thanks for new families and students attending Bilbao International Church and pray that they would feel warmly welcomed.
