Sunday 28 July

- **Moderator** | *Pray for the Moderator as he fulfils a series of appointments and engagements in the summer months – including some celebrations of PCI members who have reached 100 years of age. Continue to remember him as he prepares for what will be a very busy season starting in September when he will be leading many services in various presbyteries.*
- **Resting in God in worship** | *'The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing. He makes me lie down in green pastures, he leads me beside quiet waters, he refreshes my soul.' Psalm 23:1-3. Thank God for how he leads us into rest that renews our souls and ask that you may find refreshment for daily living as you worship today.*

Monday 29 July

- **Volker and Jinhyeog Glissmann, global mission workers, South Africa** | *Give thanks that Micha and Lukas have recently concluded important exams. Pray for the Glissmann family over these summer months, that they would know safe travels, good rest and wisdom in decision making.*

Thursday 1 August
