Sunday 22 February

- Moderator** | *Pray for the Moderator as he seeks to fulfil two roles simultaneously – that of Moderator, as well as pastoring his own congregation of Drumreagh. Ask that he will have the stamina to sustain him and wisdom to determine the correct priorities.*
- Worship: Delighted in the wisdom of God's truth** | *'Your statutes are my delight; they are my counsellors.' Psalm 119:24. Ask God that his people would find delight in the wisdom of God's truth for their lives in worship today.*

Monday 23 February
