

# Let's Pray

Sun 15 February - Sat 21 February 2026

## Sunday 15 February

- Moderator** | As we remember that 'the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their prayer. But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil' (1 Peter 3:12), pray that our lives would be marked with righteousness as we trust in the finished work of Jesus.
- Worship: Devoted as God's people** | 'They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.' Acts 2:42. Ask God that our church family in worship might be a place in which we express devotion to him and one another in his name.

## Monday 16 February

- Volker and JinHyeog Glissmann, global mission workers, Malawi** | Give thanks for conversations exploring new ways to translate TEE course materials and specifically that the Chichewa translation is now finished, while the French and Portuguese translations are nearly ready. Pray for wisdom in exploring how best to use technology in translation work. Remember also the proof-readers working on the French and Portuguese translations.
- The Presbyterian Church of Myanmar (PCM)** | Pray for the country of Myanmar where the humanitarian crisis continues to deepen following the coup five years ago. Pray for our brothers and sisters in Christ in the PCM, especially for those enduring displacement due to airstrikes, that their essential daily needs would be met. Pray for PCM's network of community schools set up in response to the crisis, that they would be adequately resourced, benefitting many children.

## Tuesday 17 February

- Rev Graham Stockdale, Prison Chaplaincy** | Pray that Graham would be enabled to effectively juggle three prison ministries – Maghaberry (4 days), Magilligan (1 day) and 'Beyond', a ministry supporting prison leavers. Pray for wisdom in knowing how to develop Beyond, staying spiritually alive while ministering to pain and brokenness. Pray also for God's spirit to be working in men's hearts.
- Lisbellaw, Lisnaskea, Maguiresbridge and Newtownbutler, Rev Rodney Beacom** | Give thanks for the good numbers attending the new Sunday evening prayer meeting which has begun as a follow on from "Finding Our Voice in Prayer", in the hope that, through prayer, the congregations would be drawn closer to the Lord in faith and fellowship.

## Wednesday 18 February

- Neil and Jenny Stewart, global mission workers, Spain** | Continue to pray for the Stewart family serving in the Basque region of Northern Spain, especially for Neil and Jenny, as they continue with language learning and building relationships. Remember the children as they continue to settle into life in Bilbao. Pray for guidance as the Basque Project Teams plan for outreach initiatives in the year ahead.
- The National Evangelical Synod of Syria and Lebanon (NESSL)** | Pray for the recovery of the health care systems in Syria and Lebanon which are currently facing critical shortages, especially of medications for those facing chronic illnesses. Pray also for the planning and running of women's conferences providing spiritual and mental health support for those enduring the trauma of conflict and war.

## Thursday 19 February

- Greystones** | Give thanks for the ministry of Rev Gary McDowell over the past decade and more. Please pray for the congregation as Gary enters retirement and they commence a time of vacancy, that they will stand strong together through the coming months. Pray for Rev Andrew Gill in his role as vacancy convener and ask that God will be preparing the person who will come.
- Ben Cavan, community outreach worker, Ballycrochan** | Pray for wisdom in planning a joint youth event with other local churches. Give thanks for young families who have been coming to church recently and pray for more new faces. Pray for those volunteers who work tirelessly for the Kingdom.

## Friday 20 February

- Peacehaven Trust** | The Trust has three residential properties for adults with a learning disability in Greystones, Co. Wicklow. Pray for Michael Williams, Regional Manager, along with the staff and residents of Peacehaven. Remember the residents as they attend day services as well as activities in and out of the houses. Pray that residents will be happy and fulfilled in their daily lives.
- Public Square** | Pray for the Peace and Reconciliation Panel and for the work that they do. Pray especially for the work that they are currently doing for the project, 'Considering Lament.'

## Saturday 21 February
